

GENERAL INFORMATION LEAFLET

Product Information: Unicoatings™ UC POLISH

Unicoatings™ UC POLISH cleans and polishes surfaces, effectively restoring a polished surface to its original colour. As a cleaner, UC POLISH removes the effects of heavy fading or chalking of a surface, usually caused by dirt, soiling, oil, salt or exposure to UV sunlight. This wax- and silicone-free polish then polishes the surface restoring its original colour and shine. UC POLISH is ideal for use on plastics, glass fibre GFK, stainless steel and any other painted surfaces. Not suitable for use on aluminium.

APPLICATION

- Before using test the surface to be polished for any scratches. Using a damp cloth or sponge, apply a generous amount of undiluted UC POLISH to the surface, ensuring a complete and even coverage. Then wipe off the UC Polish using a dry cloth or cleaning/cotton wool
- Everyday dirt will be easily removed by this method. To remove stubborn dirt you might need to repeat this method
- During the polishing process, ensure that the surface being treated remains moist; ideally use a spray bottle with water for this purpose
- To achieve a really high gloss finish to the surface we recommend using a polishing machine, fitted with a felt pad, at 2,000 – 2,500 rpm.

PACKAGING

UC POLISH is available in 0.5kg bottles or 200kg drums. For bulk orders please contact Unicoatings.

STORAGE

UC POLISH can be stored for at least 12 months in its original packaging. Protect from frost and direct sunlight.

DISPOSAL

Empty bottles and drums, as well as any remaining product, must be disposed of in accordance with your country's laws and regulations.
